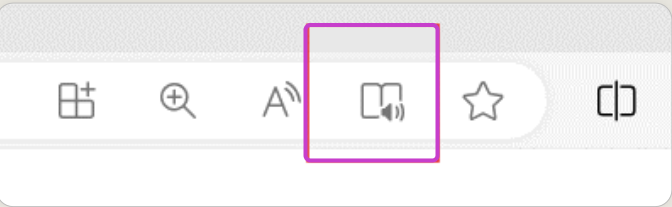

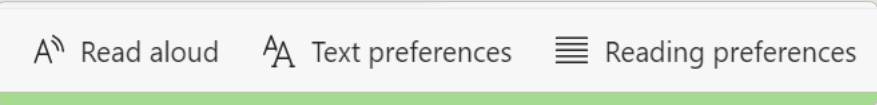
Accessibility Features in Edge enhances your browsing experience and make web content easier to read and navigate. Accessibility tools include text size adjustment, reading mode, and page contrast settings. These features are designed to help everyone enjoy a more comfortable browsing experience.

How to use Immersive Reader

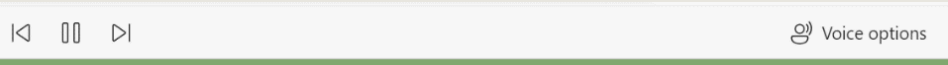
Immersive Reader can simplify the page layout without distractions. Open Microsoft Edge on your device and go to a website. If available, *(not all webpages support Immersive Reader)* click the **book icon** in the address bar to open Immersive Reader.



In Immersive Reader, you can customise text size, font style, and background colour for improved readability.



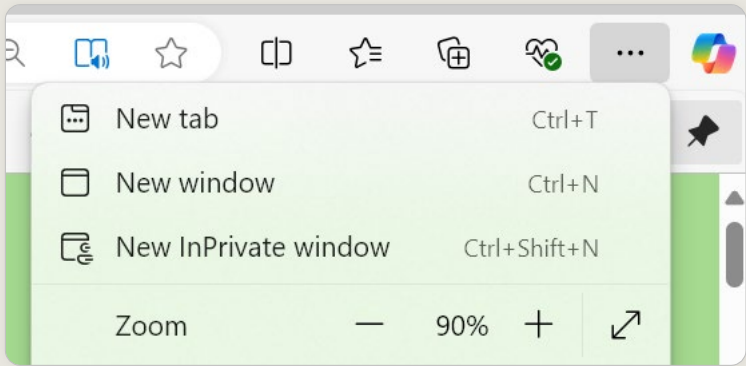
Select **Read aloud**, hear the text read to you. You can pause, skip, or change the reading voice and speed using the toolbar.



Select **Text preferences** to change the text size/spacing and page themes. Select **Reading preferences** to translate the page into another language, this will also read aloud in the chosen language.

## How to use Zoom

To quickly adjust the zoom level, click the three-dot menu in the top-right corner and use the '+' or '-' buttons next to the '**Zoom**' option, or press **Ctrl ++** or **Ctrl + -** on your keyboard.



## Accessibility Settings

To further change accessibility settings click the three-dot menu in the top right corner and select **Settings > Accessibility**. Here you can change high visibility outline around the area of focus on a page.
