	Module 3: Upgrade	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This module demonstrates the process of upgrading from previous to current versions of SharePoint Server.
	Module 4: Administration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Administration module covers various SharePoint Server administration tasks, including monitoring tools (built-in and external) and recommended daily, weekly, and monthly tasks to maintain control of your environment.
	Module 5: Troubleshooting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This module covers various approaches and tools for troubleshooting SharePoint Server issues, including available tools and the information generated by SharePoint to aid in troubleshooting.
	Module 6: PnP PowerShell for SharePoint Server	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This module introduces the Patterns and Practices (PnP) PowerShell extension modules for SharePoint Server, covering the basics and exploring common PnP cmdlets.
	Module 7: High Availability SQL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This module covers best practices for SQL Server environments supporting SharePoint farms, including initial configuration, deployment, long-term maintenance, and operations. We will also review high availability and disaster recovery options. Lab activities will guide you through various configuration and maintenance tasks.
	Module 8: SharePoint Online Migration Tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This module is an early introduction into the SharePoint Migration Tool.
